- Deploying experienced TA's to deliver focussed interventions
- provide quality CPD in core subjects and the new National Curriculum for our teachers
- provide enrichment opportunities for our children
- provide free milk and fruit
- provide free breakfast club for eligible pupils
- Provide 'Beanstalk' reading support

The attainment of pupils eligible for Pupil Premium will be recorded at the end of the academic year.
