

Dear Year 3 and your families,

Welcome back to school and to Year 3. We are really looking forward to the year ahead. This year your child's teacher will be Mrs Melton with Mrs Lloyd supporting learning.

Please find below some useful and important information which will help you support your child in school during this coming academic year:

- The gate opens at 8:30 am and children go straight into their class; the gate closes at 8:45 a.m.
- The school day ends at 3.00 pm, please ensure your child is collected on time. (Gates open at 2:55 pm)
- Your child will have spellings to learn every week with a spelling test on Fridays.
- Your child is expected to read for at least 20 minutes every evening and parents must sign the reading journal. This reading journal must be brought to school every day, so that your child can receive their star stamp. Home reading books will be changed when your child has read their book at home and in school.
- Homework will be given out or set on Fridays and needs to be completed or handed in the following **Thursday** (unless stated otherwise).
- PE lessons take place on **Tuesday mornings.** Your child should **come to school in their PE kit** on Tuesdays and **bring their uniform with them in a bag** to change into afterwards. Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit with their name clearly on (yellow t-shirt, black shorts, slip-on style pumps and tracksuit bottoms for winter.)
- Please ensure your child has a refillable water bottle and a coat/sunhat dependant on the weather.
- Our Year 3 classroom is set up and ready to learn. We have lots of exciting learning planned and together we can learn in the light of God.
