

# Holy Family School

## Autumn Termly Learning Plan

### Year 1



<p><b>RE</b></p> <p>Class saint: St Francis of Assisi Feast day 4<sup>th</sup> October</p>	<p>In RE the children will learn about Creation, Families and Celebrations, Prayer, Advent and Christmas. ~ recognise the place and value of celebrations in family, school and parish. ~ take part in celebrations which express thanks and praise. ~ hear about and explore signs of God's care and blessings in creation and human life. Through their creation work, the children will also be learning about their new class saint, St Francis of Assisi, who is the patron saint of animals and nature.</p> <p>The children will learn the traditional prayers which are the Hail Mary, Our Father and Glory Be. They will also be having fortnightly prayer services where they will choose the prayer focus items and songs to be sung. They will also be attending Mass once a month.</p>
<p><b>English</b></p>	<p>In English the children will have guided reading every day in class. They will also have a daily phonics lesson and they will learn to spell the common exception words using their phonics and sight skills. They will learn to use the correct punctuation in their writing and to use the correct terminology when using these. The focus will be traditional tales and well-known stories, which the children will read, talk about, use drama to sequence/retell and to write their own stories using time openers and ambitious vocabulary. The children will explore nonfiction books and will also listen to and perform poetry. Our class author will be Jill Murphy.</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p>	<p>The children will cover these units in their Maths work. Number and Place Value: counting to 10 and then 20 forwards and backwards, forming numbers correctly, finding 1 more or 1 less, adding and taking away and recording using the correct symbols. They will be able to recognise and name 2D and 3D.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p>	<p>The children will be covering a variety of topics and revisiting them throughout the year. The areas are Animals, plants and materials. They will also learn about the four seasons- concentrating this term on Autumn and starting Winter.</p>
<p><b>PE</b></p>	<p>Multi skills and fitness, the children will be using their skills to take part in different games. Football skills and invasion games. Gymnastics ~ travelling, rolling, jumping and balancing. They will work on linking a short sequence of movements together.</p>
<p><b>Geography/History</b></p>	<p>In geography the children will be learning about their school and what makes it special. They will use and explain about their classroom using an outline plan, understand the geography of the playground and understand and explain why maps are a useful tool. We will look at weather pattern during the seasons. In history the children will be learning about what life was like in the past (focus on the Victorian period), this will include: homes, toys and schools.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p>	<p>Esafety~ in school and at home. Learning to use the programme; 2paint, 2quiz, 2count on Purple Mash.</p>
<p><b>Art</b></p>	<p>Drawing - The children will explore mark making and line, working and experimenting with different materials.</p>
<p><b>DT</b></p>	<p>Mechanisms - The children will explore slider mechanisms and the movement they output by making a moving story book.</p>
<p><b>Music</b></p>	<p>Percussion lessons with the Music Service learning the Djembe drums. The children will listen, understand, and form an opinion about a piece of music called Danse Macabre by the composer Saint-Saens through the story of Little Red Riding Hood.</p>
<p><b>PSHE</b></p>	<p>Core theme 1: Created and loved by God. We will learn about ourselves and our feelings and emotions. We will learn about keeping healthy, being safe and taking care of ourselves.</p>
