Year 1 Summer Termly Learning plan

Subject	Focus
<p>Religious Education</p> <p>Class Saint is St. Francis of Assisi</p>	<p>Easter: We will be looking at the story of Jesus's resurrection and how people welcomed this news.</p> <p>Pentecost: We will understand the Holy spirit is God and that Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit when he went back to heaven.</p> <p>Sharing Jesus Life: We will be looking at the friendship between Jesus and his disciples.</p> <p>Following Jesus today: We will be looking at the Sacrament of Baptism and how we can follow Jesus in our lives.</p>
English	<p>Well-loved stories: Children will look at many well-loved stories and will use them as a base to create lots of different writing pieces including descriptions, letters, and recounts. We will learn about the author Anne Booth and the books she has written.</p> <p>Instructions: Children will look at why we need sets of instructions, how to follow and write them.</p> <p>Non-Fiction: Children will learn about the features of non-fiction texts and how to write a simple report.</p> <p>The children will have guided reading each day in class. They will have a daily phonics lesson and they will learn to spell the common exception words using their phonics and sight skills.</p> <p>Grammar, spelling and punctuation will be an ongoing in English.</p>
Mathematics	<p>Addition and Subtraction to 20: Knowing the number bonds to, and within, 20. Looking at doubles and near doubles and solving addition and subtraction problems.</p> <p>Place value: Recognising numbers first up to 50 and then to 100, comparing and ordering numbers, knowing one more, one less and ten more, ten less.</p> <p>Multiplication and Division: Multiplying using repeated addition, Using arrays to help multiplication and Dividing as sharing.</p> <p>Fractions: Looking at halving, finding half and a quarter of a number, looking at wholes and parts.</p>
Science	<p>Seasons: To look at Spring and Summer – what that means to the day length, clothes we wear and weather. We will visit the park during these seasons.</p> <p>Plants: We will look at plants including common plants and trees. We will look at what conditions are needed to help plants grow.</p> <p>Animals: We will be looking at the 5 senses and different body parts.</p> <p>Materials: We will be investigating what material is best used to keep us dry.</p>
Physical Education	<p><u>Outdoor sports- Sports day prep</u></p> <p>In preparation for our sports day, children will rehearse some of the sports day activities and build knowledge on game rules.</p> <p>In addition, children will develop their cricket and athletic skills.</p>
Computing	Coding: making algorithms and debugging programs
RSE/PSHE	Module 3: We will be looking at how humans are called to love others in the wider community through service, dialogue and through the working of the Common good

Geography	Children will undertake fieldwork in the school grounds and understand how important accurate instructions are to successfully follow a trail. They will learn the four cardinal points of the compass and differentiate between maps, plans and photographs. They will use symbols to identify features on maps and plans.
History	The children will learn about the British Monarchy and the coronation of His Majesty King Charles III and Queen Camilla on May 6 th 2023.
Spanish	Children will learn the months of the year and days of the week. They will also cover colours and numbers in Spanish.
Art/DT	In Art children will learn to draw and sketch various objects through observational drawing. They will also be learning about the artist Van Gough and recreating some of his pictures using paint and collage. In DT the children will learn how to make a 'healthy fruit cup.' They will research different fruits, labelling and packaging for their product. They will also evaluate their product.
Music	The children will have percussion workshops with the Music Service using the djembe drums, exploring rhythm. They will also learn to sing and perform songs.
