Support with assessment ensures children are making clear progress from baselines.  The ongoing replenishment of high-quality PE equipment encourages increased activity levels. Through intra-sports activities, children have been exposed to and competed in various sports- with the facility to transport them. Specialist

coaches are provided to ensure pupils experience a wider ra of sports activities in addition, e.g., football, dodgeball, hock tennis, rounders, cricket, rugby, and netball. Investment in swimming ensured a greater number achieved a 25m distance. Children as leaders have enabled other children to develop to PE skills ably supported by coaches and staff.	ey, e.

minibus enables a larger number of pupils to be transported to events.

Greater amount of children were able to access swimming by intensifying the sessions. All children have had the opportunity to engage in extracurricular activities -some with additional facilitation.

How has your school's spending increased pupil participation in extra-curricular activities?

Inclusive activities for all-sports coaches supported in after-school events. Teachers more confident to deliver effective PE supporting pupils to undertake extra activities with a suitable range to choose from.

How has your school's spending increased staff training and continued professional development (CPD)?

Increased confidence, knowledge, and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport- particularly assessment for all. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils resulting in more pupil engagement and pupil outcome.

How has your school's spending increased staff participation in extra-curricular activities and school sports competitions?

Staff have better knowledge to support children with such events and, more importantly, to ensure all groups particularly disadvantaged children.

How has your school's spending improved swimming attainment?

Restructuring the arrangements has targeted more children (all of KS2)to gain access to swimming. The use of a pop-up pool and instruction has facilitated this. This year, more time was spent targetted Y6 for their swimming attainment -improving greatly.

How has your school's spending improved water safety awareness?

During swimming instruction children learned about the safe and sensible approaches to swimming. This was reinforced with set assemblies from Severn Trent.
